To fully support the budget, offerings need to average \$4100 weekly <u>UPDATE FROM THE DEACONS:</u> Maturity Date on Loan w/First Dakota- October 2026. We are paid ahead of the Oct. 2026 Maturity Date, however, it is not easy to specifically calculate how many months we are paid ahead, but are possibly looking at approximately September of 2024 as a pay off date. It is a 15 year loan that began in 2011 and carries a 4.25% interest rate. The monthly payment is \$1,688.

Don't forget HyVee Cards...a fundraiser for the building fund. For each card sold, 5% comes back to RRC an easy way to increase your giving to the building fund without increasing your cost. Cards are available for \$50 and \$100. Make checks payable to RRC-BF (or Riverview Reformed Church Building Fund). THIS YEAR we have \$10 and \$25 cards also available. These make great stocking stuffers or gifts for hard to buy for people as well as helping to benefit our building fund.
