Training Regimen

Therefore lift your drooping hands and strengthen your weak knees. Hebrews 12:3-13) I'm wonderful at making plans to get in shape. Following through on them? Not so much. But I've found that the few healthy habits that have stuck have something in common—they fit into my life and become a part of my routine. To focus on drinking more water, I started carrying a water bottle with me everywhere I went. I thought about my water intake all day long and felt a sense of accomplishment when my bottle was empty.

To fully support the budget, offerings need to average \$4100 weekly UPDATE FROM THE DEACONS: Maturity Date on Loan w/First Dakota- October 2026. We are paid ahead of the Oct. 2026 Maturity Date. It is a 15 year loan that began in 2011 and carries a 4.25% interest rate. The monthly payment is \$1,688. Loan started off in 2008 at \$275,000. The past 4 years of loan totals at the end of each year are as follows: 2013 \$175,000; 2014 \$150,000; 2015 \$142,000; 2016 \$133,000.
