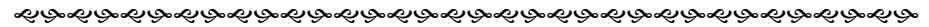

A Seminar. co-hosted by New Roots Ministry (Fred Wilgenburg) and the Office of Social Justice of the Christian Reformed Church, will be held Tuesday, October 30 at 7 PM at the Sioux Falls Ministry Center (225 E. 11th St, Sioux Falls). *Hear Dr. Jason Lief of Northwestern College speak about the history of immigration & unpack misconceptions. *Hear life stories of Dreamers affected by DACA policies. *Not taking political positions, but we will consider, “But, What Would Jesus Do?”

The Yankton Area Literacy Council is providing a program entitled “Math Is Fun” to elementary students in the Yankton School district. Volunteers work with children for 1 hour, from 3:30-4:30, each week to help them improve their addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division skills. A lot of our work is done with flash cards. When needed, we also provide assistance with time-telling and money counting skills. We are in need of tutors for each of the 4 elementary schools. Tutoring begins the first week of October through the first week of May. Many tutors are retired volunteers and are absent from time to time for travel or being with family. We work around those schedules.
