The Rev. Dr. John Hubers and his wife, Lynne, grew up in Orange City, lowa. After graduating from Northwestern College they spent two years as RCA volunteer missionaries in the Persian Gulf state of Bahrain, teaching English to Arab students. After John graduated from seminary, they would go on to serve as a pastoral ministry team with an RCA church in New York, then three different international churches in the Persian Gulf, followed by ministry at churches in Michigan and Texas. From 2001-2006, John was director of RCA mission work in the Middle East and South Asia. Then, after obtaining his PhD at the Lutheran School of Theology in Chicago, returned to Orange City where he has been teaching in the religion department at Northwestern College for the past eight years. Right now, Lynne and John are seeking support for a new RCA missionary calling—to serve as mission partners at the Mekane Yesus (Place of Jesus) Seminary in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, where John will be helping to equip Ethiopian pastors for a Christcentered ministry of outreach to Muslim neighbors. They will go as soon as they are able to raise full funding.
