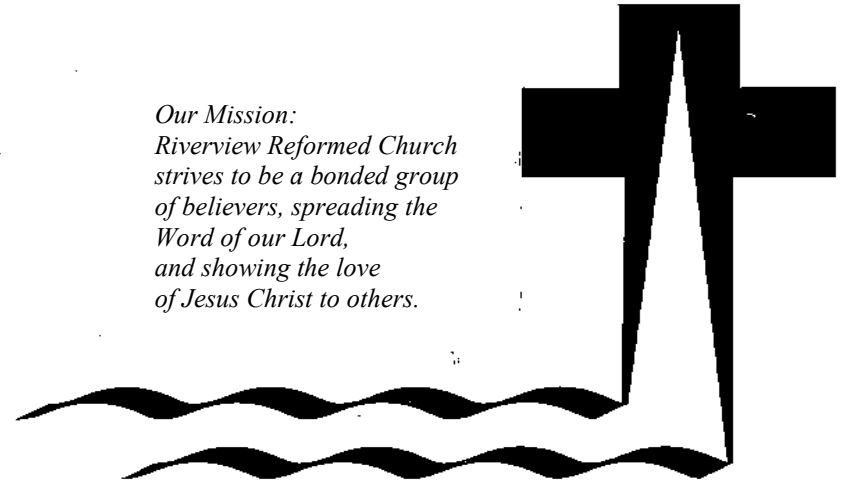

The Yankton Area Literacy Council provides a program entitled "Math is Fun" to elementary students in the Yankton School District. Volunteers work with children for 1 hour, from 3:30-4:30 PM each week to help them improve their addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division skills. A lot of our work is done with flash cards. When needed, we also provide assistance with time-telling and money counting skills. We are in need of tutors for each of the 4 elementary schools. Tutoring begins the first week of October through the first week of May. Many tutors are retired volunteers and are absent from time to time for travel or being with family. We work around those schedules.
