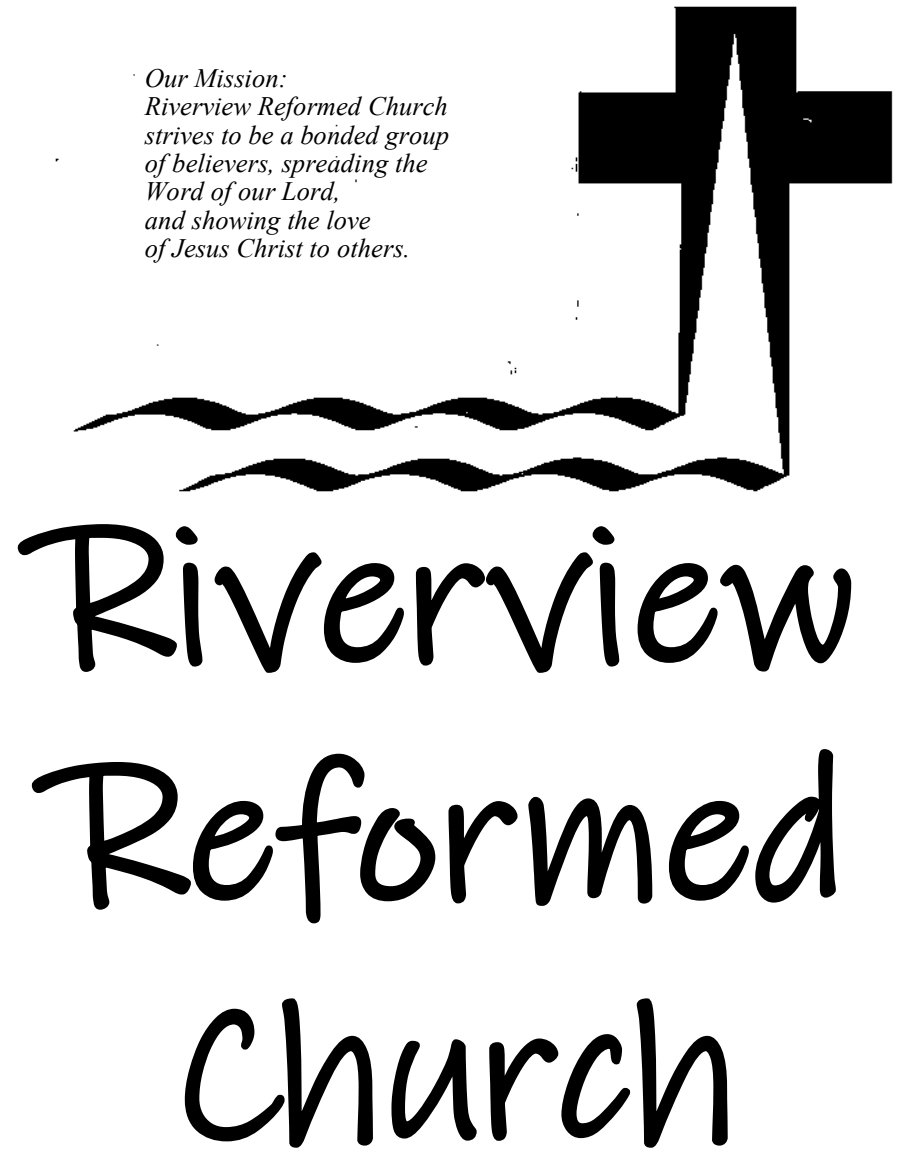

Consistory Report to the Congregation:

Meeting was held April 13, 2020.

The Deacons reported that offerings coming in are approximately 75% of the needed amount, which is \$12,000 every 4 weeks. They are in the process of applying to the Care Act to help maintain current salary levels.

There was discussion covering using Zoom for Fellowship meetings and possibly changing sermon topics to reflect emotions and what we are all going through due to COVID-19. Discussion also covered how to improve our current live-stream services.
