#### **Guide for In-Person Sunday Services**

As a Consistory we have set these guidelines as we open church up to inperson services. #### Regarding the Service:

There will be no passing of plates. There will be no greeting time. When the service is over, please wait for Ushers to come dismiss you. For those who choose not to attend, we will still be live streaming the service on YouTube, Facebook and on the Radio on FM 89.1

#### Regarding Time at Church:

No fellowship time; coffee and juice will not be served. Limited bulletins.

Areas are roped off to limit the space available to access.

Be Respectful, Keep Distance, Practice Good Hygiene, Please Don't Judge. Masks are optional, but encouraged for those with health concerns, Sanctuary will be deep cleaned once a week.
