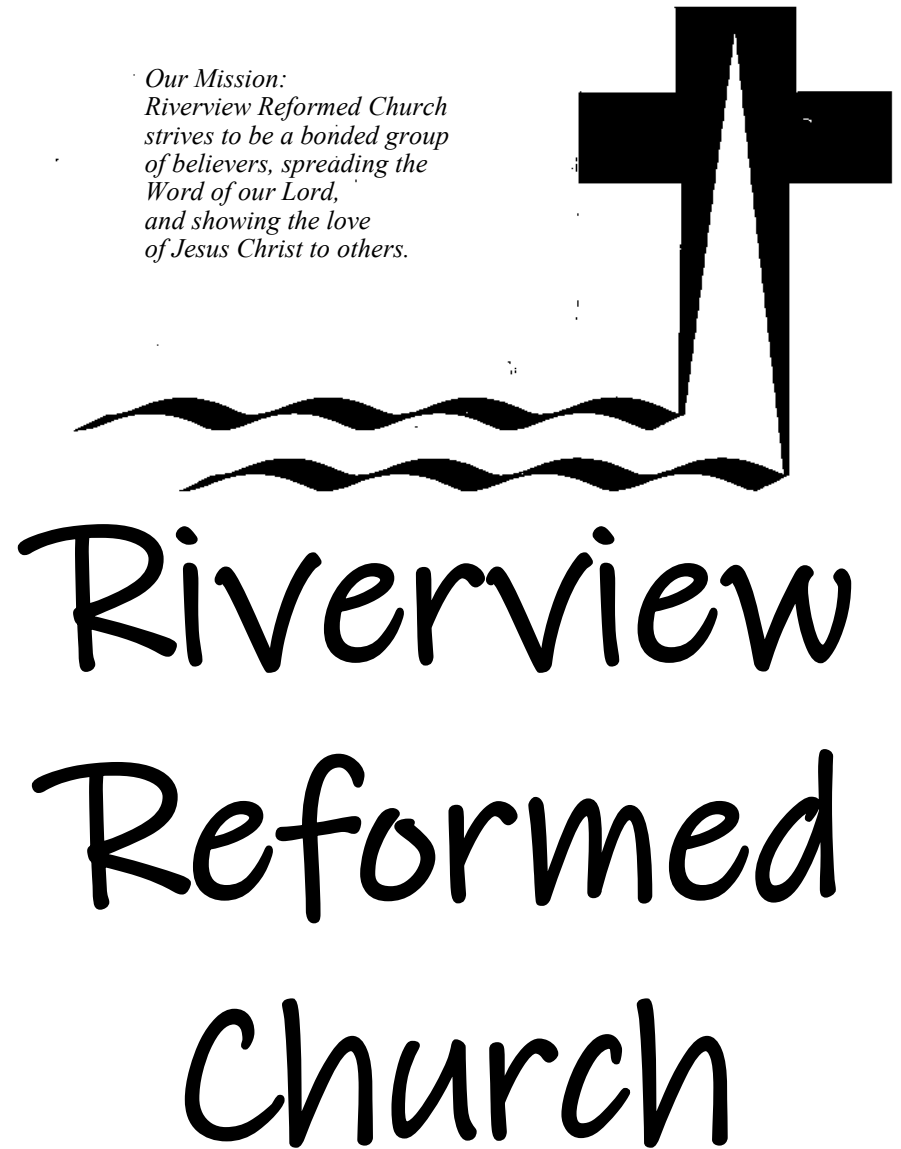

CONSISTORY REPORT TO CONGREGATION

Meetings were held on July 13.

The Elders addressed the constitutional question. They discussed the calling report and prayer requests. August communion procedures were discussed. It was decided to order pre-made communion packs to take to those who are not able to participate at church or by drive-thru.

The Deacons reported that several trees have been removed. They are waiting for the government to finalize CARES Act procedure to get that money. Weekly giving is about 75% of what it was formerly (before COVID-19).

Ministry Team meetings may be held either in person at church or via Zoom as each team feels it necessary.

There was quite a bit of discussion about selling HyVee cards before/after services each Sunday and restoring Fellowship Time after the service. After much discussion it was decided that we will continue as we have been doing with all precautions in place for now. It will be addressed at our next meeting in August as we see how things develop.

The rummage sale may proceed with necessary precautions being followed.

The 2020 Vision Team has the following recommendations:

1. Whatever happens in the next 2 years, the RCA needs restructuring to be more effective.
2. The Global Mission should be a separate entity from RCA so those who split from RCA can still support these missions.
3. They need to restructure how churches can leave to make it easier for congregations.

We are all asked to pray for the 2020 Vision Team.
