

Consistory report to congregation:

Meetings held September 14, 2020

The Elders addressed the constitutional question. They discussed those needing prayer. The pre-made communion packs to take to those who are not able to participate at church or drive-thru have arrived. A sign up sheet will be sent out to members. Kits will be mailed to college students in time for them to participate with the online communion service.

The Deacons reported that there is a \$6000 shortfall each month to cover the budget. At the present time there is some money in the account which was set aside for emergency situations. Giving needs to increase or that money will continue to go toward paying the bills. The deacons will make sure repairs to the restroom to the south of the sanctuary are completed. Ministry Team meetings may be held either in person at church or via Zoom as each team feels it necessary. Online curriculum coming from the RCA-CRC will be ordered for Sunday School. Parents may participate online but the curriculum is also conducive for Sunday morning lessons. A local motel room for those in need will be the Mission of the Month.

HyVee cards will be sold in the Fellowship Hall to promote social distancing. Sunday services will remain as they are for 2-3 more months as we see what happens with COVID. One church has just reopened and no churches are having fellowship at this time.

The Consistory went through the Classis Essentials/Commitment form. A cub scout troop which typically meets at the Methodist Church was approved to use the RRC basement for their meetings until the Methodist Church allows outside building usage.

Pastor Jake will take the week of October 19-25 off for continuing education.
