

CONSISTORY REPORT TO CONGREGATION

Meetings held October 12

The Elders addressed the constitutional question. They discussed those needing prayer. A letter will be sent to members who have not been able to meet in person, asking how the elders can serve them and their needs. Drive thru communion continues to be utilized. The Classis meeting will be held November 13 and 14 at Inspiration Hills.

The Deacons reported that the shortfall last month was \$2600. They are still asking members to increase their giving to meet expenses each month. The deacons made necessary drainage repairs to the restroom in front of the sanctuary. CARES funds were used in accordance with the guidelines and do not have to be repaid. Some tree removal will be done next spring. Pastor Jake led the Consistory in a Dream/Mission session. He asked the questions: Who is RRC? How are we living into our Mission Statement? What is God saying to us? What are we going to do about it?

We are looking for someone to take over organizing/contact person for when we serve the Banquet at the UCC Building. Our next scheduled serve date looks to be next April 2021, but will know more as the year/time comes. If this is something you are willing to do, please contact the church office, or Sharon Auch-Bylander.. Sharon will be able to inform you on what it all consists of. She is also willing to help whoever takes over, but does not want to be in charge of it at this time anymore.

Adult Sunday School With Covid cases still unsure, we will hold off with beginning the Adult Sunday School classes, since the class is listening to CD's in a smaller room. If someone else wishes to begin the classes with smaller groups, or with all required to wear masks, talk to the church office and we can give you the material. Otherwise we will re-assess the situation in 2-3 months.
