

DAKOTA CLASSIS DISCERNMENT TEAMS We will be holding meetings for all members to attend, if you wish to find out more about the Discernment of the Dakota Classis, please attend the meetings. The reason for the 2020 Vision Team is the realization of a great divide in the RCA around Biblical Interpretation. One of the main examples of this is in regards to the interpretations of the view of marriage. RCA officially holds the traditional view of marriage between men and women, but there are individual pastors, churches and Classis acting outside the bounds of this interpretation of the Bible. Under this understanding the discernment team discerns major pathways to resolve this conflict (internal separation "they leave" or external separation "we leave"). WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR RRC? Where do we find ourselves in this conversation realizing that even our own church is all on the same page? An email was sent out regarding information on this, with a listing of times of meetings and who should attend which meeting, to keep them smaller for Covid reasons.
