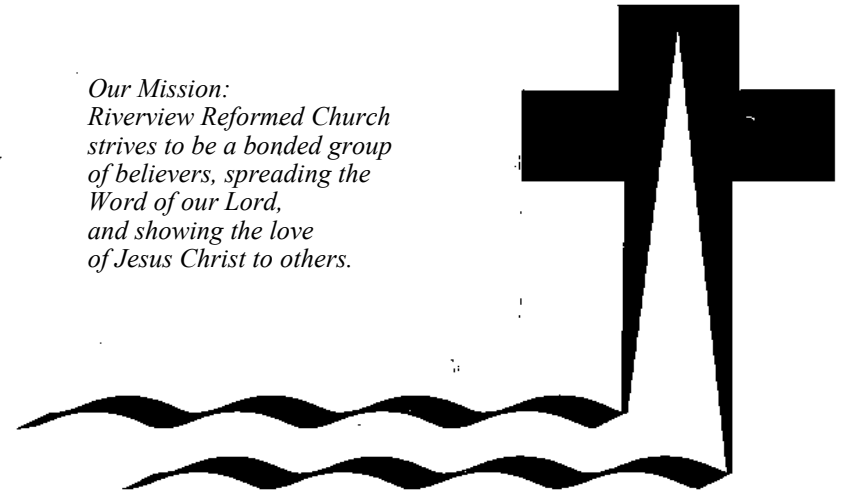

CONSISTORY UPDATE FROM JANUARY 11 MEETING: New officers were elected: Alan Egge as Vice President, Doyle Guthmillers as Clerk, and Shane Bertsch as Head Deacon. Topics covered were the annual Consistorial Report, Boy Scouts repainting lines in the parking lot, Congregation Information meetings, Special Classis Meeting about leaving the RCA, the Banquet, and Soupleless Soup Kitchen. The Consistory wanted to thank the Congregation for all their giving in 2020. While it has been a tough year, our giving was good enough that we didn't qualify for more federal aid at this time. The consistory voted to follow city guidelines on mask mandating.

CONSISTORY UPDATE FROM FEBRUARY 1 MEETING: The Elders met and started a membership review, and the possibility of a membership class because of a variety of requests for baptisms and membership. Deacons reported that Classis Assessments per member will be \$115.17 per member for this year. The Consistory voted to sign a petition declaring our intent to leave the RCA with other churches in Dakota Classis.
