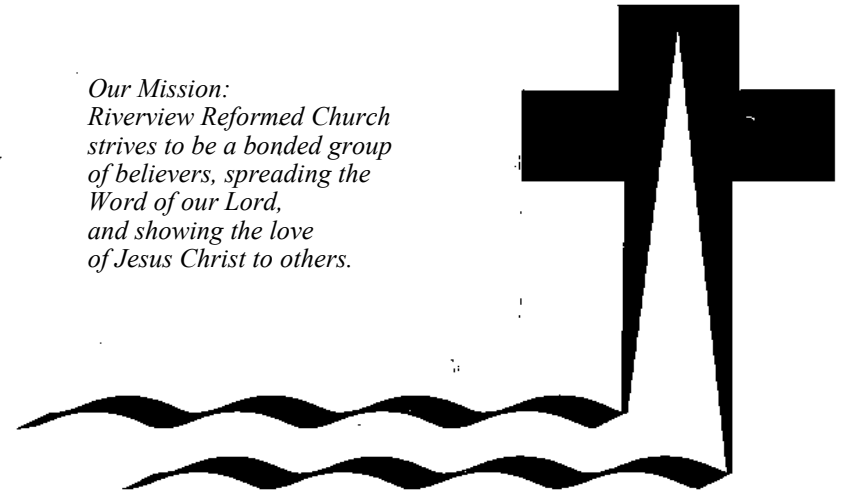

THE BANQUET UPDATE

RRC will serve the Banquet at the UCC Building on April 8. We are looking for anyone willing to come help brown the ground beef on Monday (tomorrow) at 4:30 PM. Also, those who volunteered to bring cookies or bars, you may bring them to OUR church kitchen by tomorrow (when browning the ground beef) or have them here in our kitchen by 3:00 PM on Thursday.

Help with live-stream/power point Things are finally finding new routines with church after covid brought changes. One of those changes was streaming our Sunday services. Now that the changes made for streaming are stable for the long term, we are asking for volunteers to help with Streaming/Sound board and Powerpoint. If you are interested in helping or have questions with streaming and sound board, we ask you to please contact Pastor Jake, Dan Sanow, or Todd Carr. If you are interested in helping with Powerpoint, which is just pushing a button to move the slide forward, please put your name down on the sign up sheet in the foyer.

Membership Class The Elders have decided to offer a membership class due to requests for membership and baptisms. This class is not meant only for those considering membership, but for anyone who would like to better understand the church of Riverview Reformed that they are a part of both current members and regular attendees. The class will be an hour for four weeks starting in April. It will cover Who are we?, What we believe?, What are the sacraments (Baptism and Communion) and Next Steps. If you are interested, please contact Pastor Jake, so we can gauge interest and then determine dates and times.

Consistory Meeting Update: Consistory was held on Monday, March . The Elders discussed changes to how we do communion during covid, and offering a membership class. The deacons reported on our current financial situation with current checking being \$43,000 and mortgage at \$48,484.60. The Souplless Soup Kitchen got within a couple hundred of its \$5,000 matching number (\$4,634.00 to date), which will go to the next mortgage payment. Consistory has made changes to the guidelines for in-person services that will provide more seating in the sanctuary as more people come to in-person services.

Opening/Closing Church building We have gotten a couple more volunteers to help with opening/locking the building on Sunday mornings, but can always use a few more. The more we have, the fewer times a year everyone has to help. If you are interested, please sign the sheet on the foyer table, and we'll get you on the next rotation schedule.
