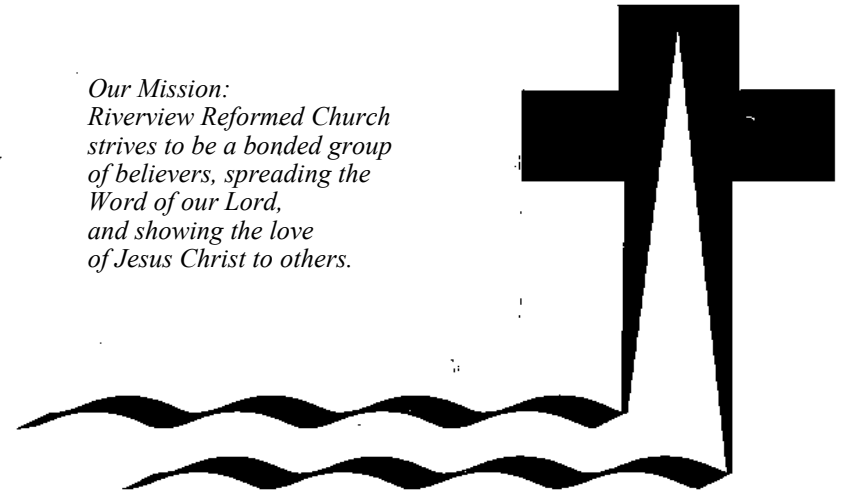

### **Consistory meeting update for August 9:**

The Elder's considered and approved a transfer of membership, a baptism and a new member. The Deacons have been busy installing handrails in the sanctuary, removing pine trees, and fixing things around the church. A work day is being planned for September 11 at 9 AM. Current finances are at \$33,633.76 and the mortgage is at \$26,739. As a Consistory, we discussed Acts 1:1-11 which Jesus ascends to heaven, which led to spirited conversation about spiritual gifts and prayer. Consistory looked ahead to the ministry teams meeting this month on the 24 and fall opportunities. Consistory discussed the August congregational meeting and what the next steps are now we have decided to leave the RCA and join ARC. A discipleship opportunity was discussed that Pastor Jake plans to participate in for the next 2 years. Consistory approved being used as a place for emergencies by Emergency Management for Yankton County.
