

#### EXPLANATION OF THE RED AND BLUE HYMNALS:

Our traditional Hymnal that we have used is the <u>red</u> "Great Hymns of the Faith" Hymnal. We will continue to use that as our primary hymnal. However, we were given a FREE DONATION of the <u>blue</u> "The Hymnal for Worship & Celebration". Some of the hymns are the same in both books, however, there are a few different ones that we will on occasion incorporate into our service. We have also used #312 "To Be God's People" and #574 "If My People's Hearts Are Humbled". We currently have enough to put 2 hymnals per pew. The words to the hymns will always be available up on the power point, just like with the red hymnal, so if you prefer not to hold a hymnal, the words are still available to you. But we do know that there are some who like to use the hymnals to follow the notes and music, so they are available, 2 in each pew. If a song will be used from both hymnals, we will designate that in the bulletin and the power point, which book and page to use. If you find a song in either book you would like sung some Sunday, please feel free to suggest it to the church office. Requests are always welcome.

**Toy Military Soldiers available** Available on the foyer counter and Fellowship Hall tables are baskets of small toy Military Soldiers. Please take one or two home with you.
