

## EXPLANATION OF THE <u>RED</u> AND <u>BLUE</u> HYMNALS:

Our traditional Hymnal that we have used is the <u>red</u> "Great Hymns of the Faith" Hymnal. We will continue to use that as our primary hymnal. However, we were given a FREE DONATION of the <u>blue</u> "The Hymnal for Worship & Celebration". Some of the hymns are the same in both books, however, there are a few different ones that we will on occasion incorporate into our service. We have also used #312 "To Be God's People" and #574 "If My People's Hearts Are Humbled". We currently have enough to put 2 hymnals per pew.
