

October 11 Consistory Update: At our most recent Consistory meeting, we considered a passage from Mark 1:9-20. In this passage are three main stories, Jesus' Baptism, Jesus' Temptation, and Jesus' calling disciples. Looking back at the meeting and this passage there was more than one overlap, as Elders considered the needs and struggles of our congregation, as we considered our next congregation meeting where we would call members of our church to serve, and as we discussed Pastor Jake's responsibilities and calling here at our church. What seems to be clear is that God is at work through our congregation as Pastor Jake considers more discipleship opportunities, looking forward to the Thanksgiving Eve Service, and all the work of the Deacons as they work on projects on the church. Through them we have been able to help those in need in our community and congregation and keeping up with the church's finances, current balance \$25607.67, with \$21867 left on our debt. Pray for the Elders and Deacons leading our church, and pray for our church and God's will for us.

Butter Braid Fundraiser is still coming up in November. This is a church-wide fundraiser. We will start selling on November 15 and end December 1. Butter braids will be delivered to church on December 14.
