

January 17 Consistory Update:

For Consistory, scripture came from John 13:1-17, at the heart of discussion was the humility of Jesus and his calling of discipleship and what that looks like. It was also recognized that this was the first meeting as an ARC church and not an RCA church, as we embark on this new adventure. Elders voted to have BJ as the new clerk. Discussion was held on how to reach out to those in our church family we haven't seen or don't know what is going on with. There was much discussion on various individuals and how families are doing, how to build responsibility and accountability into our church culture, and lastly a call to prayer as we consider these things. The Deacons discussed holding another Soupless Soup Kitchen with cases rising with proceeds going to the building fund along with the building loan right around \$15,000. It was approved to let a cub scout group meet at church. There was some discussion on transition from ARC to RCA, Pastor Jake is looking into insurance options, projects around the church. Current finances discussed with checking balance being \$21,267.38. The rest of consistory time was focused on Pastor Jake's responsibilities with an inquiry about children's message discussed, update on ARC, call to prayer for school system and medical facilities, and what are the roles of Elder and Deacon.
