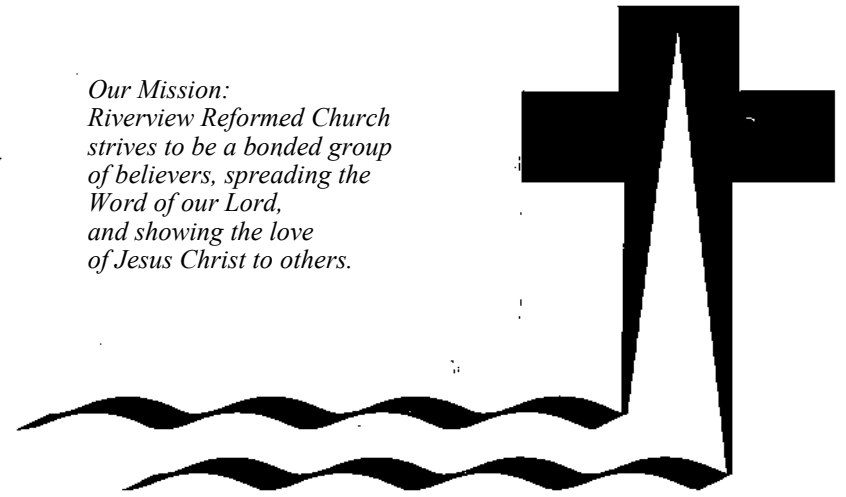

“SOUPLESS” SOUP KITCHEN

We are going to be doing a “soupless” Soup Kitchen again this year. We are requesting monetary donations, to cover what you would normally use/buy/ donate for food donations in the past years. You may make your donations with a check (to the church) or by cash. You can write one check for your weekly offering and Soupless donation, but please indicate how much you wish to go to each. We will be accepting “soupless” donations thru the month of March, (March 31). Proceeds will help support the Building Fund. If you have any questions, you can talk to a Deacon.

Mission possibility For anyone looking for an extra mission to help support, on the bulletin board in the Fellowship Hall is information on “Hope for the Hopeless H20”. This organization was founded by people, including Doyle Becker (Virginia Ballard’s brother) who lives in Sioux Falls. They are helping people in Liberia, particularly orphans. They found a need in which these orphans were being housed in a 3 bedroom location (many children sleeping on the floors), so they are helping to build a proper orphanage, school, etc. Doyle Becker is the financial officer, so you can be assured that all money goes directly to “Hope for the Hopeless” and is not lining the pockets of a rich CEO in an office.

“It Is Well With My Soul”

Did you know, the song “It is Well With My Soul” was written by a successful Christian lawyer Heratio Spafford. His only son died at age 4 in 1871. In 1872, the great Chicago fire wiped out his vast estate, made from a successful legal career. In 1873, he sent his wife and four daughters over to Europe on a summer trip on the ill fated SS Ville du Havre. Since he had a lot of work to do, he planned to follow them later. The ship sank and he lost his four daughters with the wife being the only survivor. She sent him a famous telegram which simply read, “Saved alone...”. On his return home, his Law firm was burned down and the insurance company refused to pay him. They said it was an act of God. He had no money to pay for his house and no work, he also lost his house. Then while sitting and thinking what’s happening to him, being a spiritual person, he wrote a song—“Whatever, my Lord, You have taught me to say—It is well, it is well with my soul’. My dear friend, a good attitude will determine your attitude. When you look at your life, career, job or family life, what do you say? Do you praise God? Do you blame the devil? A good attitude towards God makes Him move on your behalf. Just sit down and say, “Today, God, it is well with my soul, I am thankful I had a peaceful sleep, I am thankful I am alive with possibilities, I am thankful I have a roof over me, I am thankful I have a job, I am thankful that I have family and friends. Above all, I am thankful that I have the Lord Jesus Christ on my side.” Be blessed and don’t be envious or shocked when others are prospering because you don’t know what they have been through to get there (tests, trials, and tribulations), so thank God for what you have. “Little is much when God is in it. It is well with my soul!” If God is for us, who can be against us?
