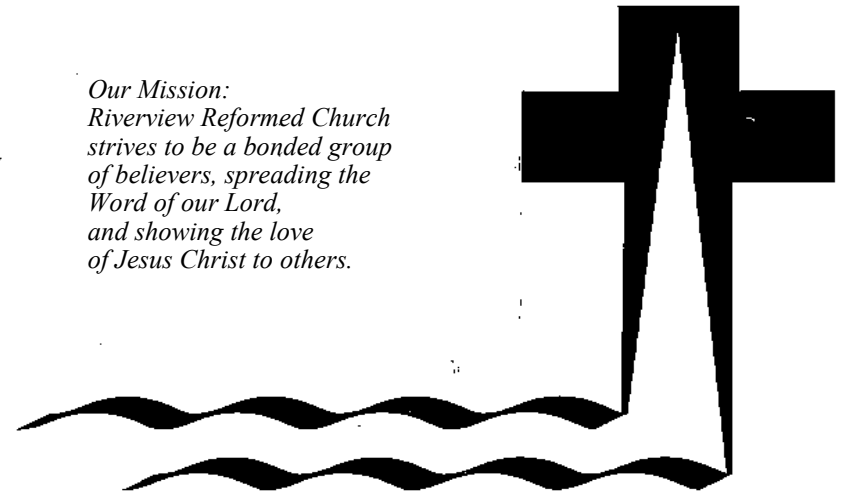

MARCH 14 Consistory Update:

Our devotion at Consistory was from Acts 2:36-47. The passage helped us dig deeply in the question “what is church?” We had a very powerful discussion around the church in Acts and the church at RRC. Two of the biggest take-aways were around having testimonies be a part of the service and that only by having a deep desire to love and follow the resurrected Jesus can we be what a church is called to be. Seth, Class/Network Pastor, was able to join and explore with us Pastor Jake’s responsibilities and what accountability can look like for members now that we have joined ARC. Discussion around the creation of a team of 6-8 member from church to be formed to discern with Seth the future of RRC. It was noted that in April we will only have communion once, on April 14 at the Maundy Thursday service, and NOT on the first Sunday of April. Deacons discussed current finances being: checking \$20,854.22, HyVee account balance \$12,503.01, Souplless Soup Kitchen \$2,566, Loan Balance \$12,608.06, and a donation of \$500 to be sent to help people in Ukraine.
