May 9 Consistory Update:

Devotions this month came from John 14:1-6 where we discussed the comfort of Jesus, the exclusion of salvation in Jesus alone, the power of trust and family aspects of Christianity among many things. As Elders, we talked about the need to pray for others and for personal devotions, we discussed those in need in our congregation and how we plan to do communion in June differently.
