

AUGUST 15 CONSISTORY

For The August Consistory meeting, our devotions came from Ezra 8:21-36. We had a lively discussion about how much gold and silver was talked about in the passage, how important prayer is especially as they sought protection on their journey, and how glad we have Jesus' sacrifice and don't need animal sacrifices. We also discussed the roles as Christians and leaders being consecrated and that accountability is important as we seek to follow God's will and offer ourselves freely to his way. As Elders, we discussed things going on with members and how the most recent communions with feedback related to spacing between elders and making sure we are not missing people who remain seated.
