RIVERVIEW REFORMED CHURCH

~CELEBRATING 60 YEARS~

The first services were held in the newly completed building of the "Yankton Reformed Church" on February 18, 1962.

On September 5, 1962 the church was renamed Riverview Park Reformed Church, derived from the name of that section of Yankton... the Riverview Park Addition.

On October 5, 2008 the Riverview Park Reformed congregation began the Sunday worship service at the original church home located at 19th and Burleigh Streets and then walked the 2 blocks to conclude the service at the new church home at 17th and Burleigh Streets. With this move the name was shortened to Riverview Reformed Church as we are no longer in the Riverview Park Addition.

AUGUST 15 CONSISTORY

For The August Consistory meeting, our devotions came from Ezra 8:21-36. We had a lively discussion about how much gold and silver was talked about in the passage, how important prayer is especially as they sought protection on their journey, and how glad we have Jesus’ sacrifice and don’t need animal sacrifices. We also discussed the roles as Christians and leaders being consecrated and that accountability is important as we seek to follow God’s will and offer ourselves freely to his way. As Elders, we discussed things going on with members and how the most recent communions with feedback related to spacing between elders and making sure we are not missing people who remain seated. As Deacons, they reported a current checking balance of \$8,669.69, still collecting names of people with church keys, mission opportunities, such as Sack Pack and donations match with that, possibility of selling lighting equipment, fall work day working on landscaping and building work and changes with Pastor Jake retirement services. The rest of the Consistory focused on final edits for by-laws, possible changes in Pastor Jake’s responsibilities with this Youth Group Partnership and his Alliance ordination transfer, next steps/direction on considering the future of our church and what is going on in Yankton Ministerial.
