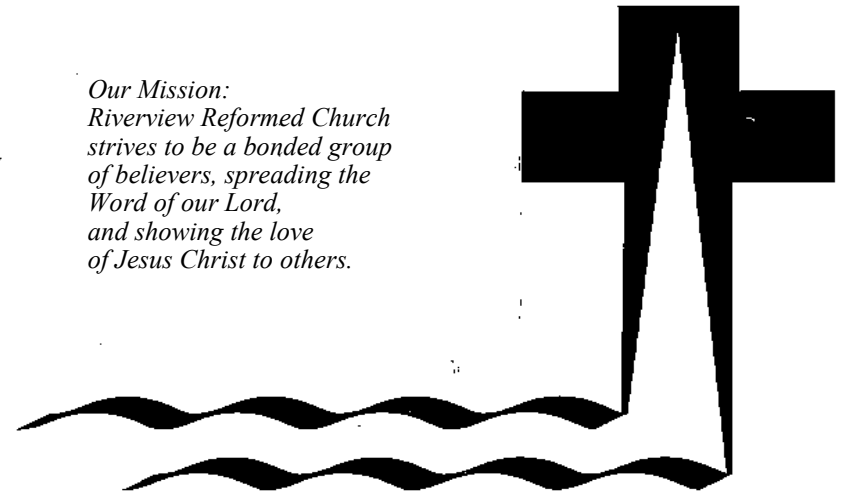

February 13 Consistory Update

Consistory began with a devotion from 1 Timothy 3:1-16. The discussion revolved around leadership, the standards laid out in scripture, how far we fall short, the responsibility of Christian leaders and the grace of Jesus. From the Elders, we heard about the transfer of membership of Sylvia Coulson, calling report and needs in our church family, and new people to church. From the Deacons, we heard about ordering a Knox Box, the repair of a bathroom downstairs, an update on Soupless Soup Kitchen, missions over the next couple of months, and doing a free will offering eventually for Becky Frank. Current finances are checking balance \$9853.34, HyVee Building Fund \$12952.34, and Youth \$875.96. The rest of the consistory meeting we heard an update on the Alliance of Reformed Churches, Pastor Jake's responsibilities, changing authorized person for our bank account, and considering the hopes and realities we have for our church.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY FROM RRC MISSIONS TEAM:

There has arisen a need in our community for a place for homeless people to go during the day. Many of the homeless in our community, while they wait for a place to stay permanently, don't usually have a place temporarily during the day. This has led to them hanging out at the library, local businesses and other warm places while they wait. This need has led to conversations between Pathways, the Yankton Ministerial and City Officials to find a solution. These conversations have led Discovery Church to volunteer their Gathering Grounds Coffee Shop space for this need. Since a place has been found, the next step has been to find volunteers to keep Gathering Grounds open for the day until the Pathway night shelter opens/closes where many of these people have been staying.

RRC's Mission's team is also considering giving financial assistance to this endeavor as there are financial needs to keep the space open and to have things like coffee available. If interested, please feel free to contact Pastor Jake with more questions. There will be training for the volunteers like mental health training and the guidelines to be followed.
