

MARCH 13 CONSISTORY UPDATE We began our Consistory meeting with a devotion out of James Chapter 5. Our discussion of the devotion centered around the power of prayer, God's presence in prayer, and the need for confession and turning from sins. The Elder report was given, which covered a devotion about God's love and knowing his love for us. A time for prayer was taken as we considered our church. Confession of Faith classes are being planned, Communion for April is on Palm Sunday and Maundy Thursday, bulletin announcements, and a membership letter. The Deacon report was given, which covered various projects around the church building, a treasurer position and tithing opportunities. The Soupless Soup Kitchen was one of these opportunities where \$2,633 was raised. The checking balance currently is at \$9,287.27, HyVee account \$12,590.38, and Youth fund is \$875, but funds have been raised but not yet deposited in anticipation for Rocky this summer. Other items discussed during Consistory focused on updating Pastor Jake's Primary and Secondary Responsibilities, and an Alliance of Reformed Churches update.
