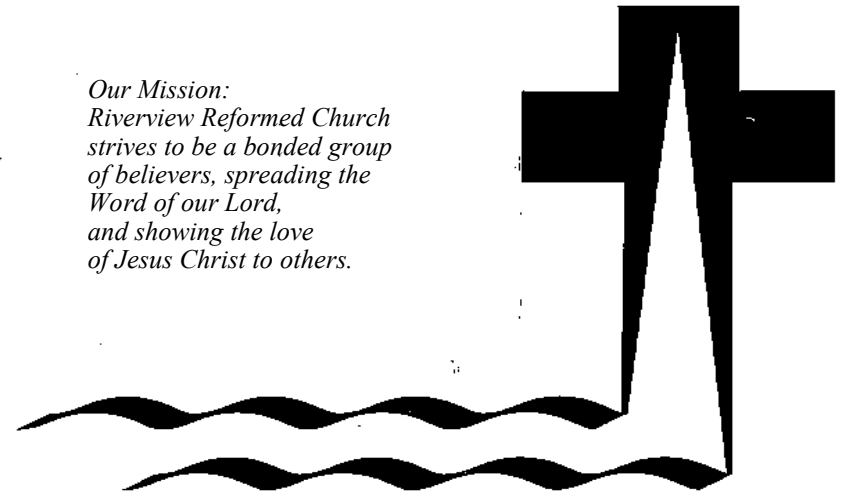

Five ways to deepen your love for Jesus this season

Cling to Truth

Where the enemy whispers lies, God's Word speaks unending truth. Meditate on Scripture to remind yourself of God's goodness, mercy, patience, faithfulness, love, and forgiveness...and the way that Jesus perfectly exhibited each of these traits during His time on Earth.
