Consistory Meeting 4/10/23

Consistory began as it always does with prayer and devotions. To begin, we did both as we looked at Luke 11:1-13 as we considered Jesus teaching on prayer. We had much discussion around the persistence we need as we pray, the desire for relationship inherent in praver between God and us, and the need for praver that we have, we ended with a word of prayer. The Elders reported that they discussed many individuals who had been reached out to because of health issues, or as we continue to pursue our covenant partners. The Elders approved the transfer of membership of Kevin and Tonia DeJong to Emmanuel Reformed in Springfield. The process was discussed around a letter that will go out to the members of Riverview Reformed as we look to the future of our church and who is continuing in that journey with us as a covenant community.
