

June 12 Consistory Update: Consistory explored together our devotion from Psalm 42:1-11 where each member shared something based on God's word. There was much shared reflection on the struggle of life and the difficulties we find in it, while also reflecting on the peace and hope we can find in God when we trust in him. The Elders report was given where we focused on those in our church who are in need of care and visits that were made in the last month, membership review was discussed with letters being sent out in the next month and lastly a discussion around the future of RRC. The Deacons report explored work they had done fixing the Blue Cross outside, changes with Bluepeak, A/C unit in Pastor Jake's office, work done to the south steps, and other financial payments.
