

August 14 Consistory Update:

Consistory began with a devotion from Joshua 24:1-15. The discussion revolved around Joshua asking Israel how they will serve the Lord, there was also discussion on God's faithfulness, that we can't save ourselves, and the need to know Jesus personally as our Lord and Savior. The elders reported having reached out to all the members lately through their letters and discussed needs in our community while also naming the tragedy in Hawaii.
