

# April 22 Special Consistory Report

We began by reflecting on Romans 8:1-11 where we discussed the tension between sinful desires and life in the spirit, we recognized the need for Jesus and the Spirit's presence in our life to belong to God, lastly we recognized the promises and hope of being Children of God when we belong to Christ. This led to a call to be honest as we try to move forward together and to remember this is our church but not about us, instead what we are doing needs to be about Jesus who the Church belongs to. This also included an emphasis to focus on our vision (Know Jesus + Make Jesus Known) as we make decisions. We continued our discussion on the proposals offered at our last meeting, where we had good conversation around the proposals. The Consistory has now approved a new mission based on Acts 1:7-8 (Know Jesus in an uncertain world + Make Jesus Known led by the Spirit), moving of pews, keeping table and chairs in the sanctuary, having Dave Reck preach more and inviting the Network to intentionally walk alongside us as we consider the future of RRC.
