

October 14 Consistory Report Consistory for October, we began with

our devotion from Anatomy of a Revived Church Chapter 3. We discussed a lot about how to keep score regarding ministry through tracking things like worship attendance, ministry group attendance, and tithing, not to measure success but as a way to hold our ministry accountable to doing the things God is calling us to do. We also discussed how this accountability can take many shapes like thanking people for their giving or service and can be as simple as asking the question of how what we are doing is living into our vision. As elders we checked in about those in need of care and prayer, and discussed things around communion. Deacon reported financials: checking-\$47,058, HyVee-\$17,670, Youth—\$1,073. Deacons communicate changes around who will be doing snow removal, repair needed for the organ, new carpet in nursery, asset management for church, removing more pews sometime, and Keith Herrboldt as the new janitor. Mission of the month is Sack Pack. Consistory also discussed next Ministry team meeting to be November 6 at 6 PM, Alliance of Reformed Churches has a new director, Midwest Network will be having a meeting on Nov. 8-9 in Sioux Falls, that the vision and Mission of RRC has been changed to Know Jesus + Make Jesus Known by Share Jesus in an Uncertain World Led by the Spirit will begin to be introduced and implemented and lastly that training will begin soon as we consider a new Framework for Ministry Teams.
