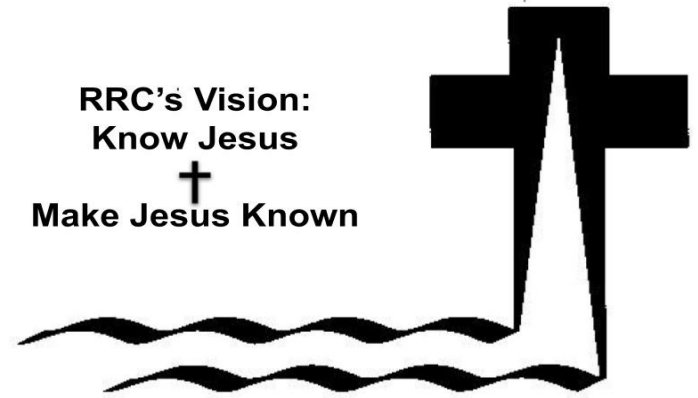

\*Pray individually at home, at church, or walking around the church. This can be done with the prayer document mentioned above or however you feel led, but be encouraged to pray for our church.

\*A while back we invited people to pray at 3:05 based on a passage from John 15:5. The Consistory has decided to update the time we are praying and the verse we are praying over. This comes from the work that Consistory has been doing, we invite you to pray at 1:08 every day based on Acts 1:7-8 NIV, which says, "He said to them: 'It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'"

**November 11 Consistory Report** We had a very lengthy conversation regarding the importance of prayer, especially as a church considers their future, God's will, and the importance of being persistent and consistent in prayer. As Elders we discussed prayer concerns for many individuals and families in our church, Thanksgiving Eve service, and people going through profess of faith. Deacons reported checking \$42,445, HyVee \$18,485, Youth \$1,173. Deacons also reported on projects in church like the organ repair, new direction signs, moving pews and Mission of the Month. There was some discussion around Pastor Jake having some opportunities for Cont. education, attending an Alliance meeting, and using accountability funds. The rest of Consistory was focused on things going on with Ministry Teams, Pastor Jake doing some volunteer opportunities, seeking partnerships with other churches, looking at the budget based on vision and mission and 2025, and thanking Robert & Lesa Palsma for their service as janitors.
