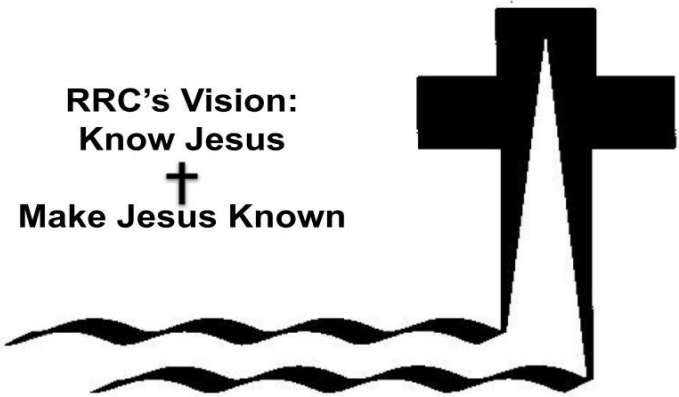

**January 15 Consistory Report** Devotions were from Ch. 6 of Anatomy of a Revived Church, the topic was around Silver bullets that churches try to find to fix issues in the church and how they don't work. Some of the Silver bullets mentioned are The Pastor, The Money, The Music, The Location, and The Facility. It was acknowledged that there are no silver bullets, but hope needs to rest in Jesus and intentional hard work in the pursuit of renewal. Elders report focused on the health concerns of members in the church or connected to the church, along with some areas that are ongoing conversation related to possible riders for church participants and worship music. The Deacons report Checking \$40,991, HyVee \$12,788, and Youth \$1,173 and looking for a mission of the month for January. After hearing reports, Consistory discussed what consistory members are part of which ministry teams, how Pastor Jake's various volunteer opportunities are going with the Hymn Sing and Majestic Bluffs Chapel service being positive first experiences, and lastly we discussed some possible groups participating in a Sunday Service sometime.
