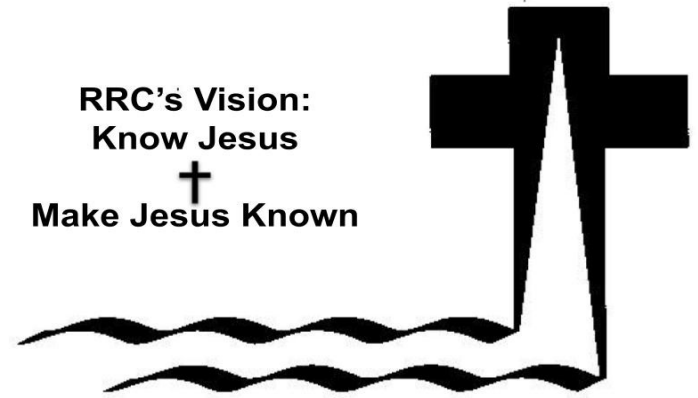

PRAYER OPPORTUNITY: There has been a document created to help focus our prayers for the future of RRC. If you would like a copy of the document that helps focus our prayers as RRC considers the future, please ask Pastor Jake for a copy.

Here are some options for ways to pray:

*Pray individually at home, at church, or walking around the church. This can be done with the prayer document mentioned above or however you feel led, but be encouraged to pray for our church.

*A while back we invited people to pray at 3:05 based on a passage from John 15:5. The Consistory has decided to update the time we are praying and the verse we are praying over. This comes from the work that Consistory has been doing, we invite you to pray at 1:08 every day based on Acts 1:7-8 NIV, which says, "He said to them: 'It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'"

2024 Financial Statements are in your church mailboxes—if you gave offerings via: Tithely or in person with check/cash, and if it was recordable, you have a church mailbox, even if you are not a 'member' of the church.

January 15 Consistory Report Devotions were from Ch. 6 of Anatomy of a Revived Church, the topic was around Silver bullets that churches try to find to fix issues in the church and how they don't work. Some of the Silver bullets mentioned are The Pastor, The Money, The Music, The Location, and The Facility. It was acknowledged that there are no silver bullets, but hope needs to rest in Jesus and intentional hard work in the pursuit of renewal. Elders report focused on the health concerns of members in the church or connected to the church, along with some areas that are ongoing conversation related to possible riders for church participants and worship music. The Deacons report Checking \$40,991, HyVee \$12,788, and Youth \$1,173 and looking for a mission of the month for January. After hearing reports, Consistory discussed what consistory members are part of which ministry teams, how Pastor Jake's various volunteer opportunities are going with the Hymn Sing and Majestic Bluffs Chapel service being positive first experiences, and lastly we discussed some possible groups participating in a Sunday Service sometime.
