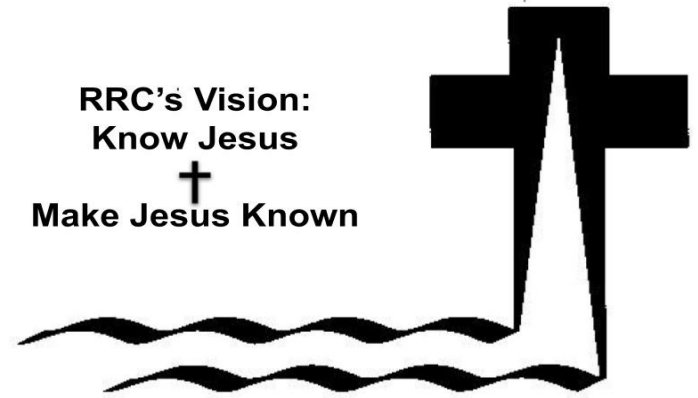

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'"

With that being said, please prayerfully consider where you can help out at RRC. It's a privilege to share your gifts with the family of God and RRC. There are so many opportunities to serve here at RRC—find a place where you are comfortable. From Lay leaders to organists, piano players, praise song leaders, greeters, Power point helpers, Sound System, teachers, Nursery sitters, opening/closing, Fellowship hosts, prayer warriors (including pre-service prayer time). Pray, and ask God where he would have you serve and be a blessing to others in the family of God at RRC. And if you aren't comfortable being on a rotation schedule, let us know if you are willing to be a substitute, to fill in here and there when needed. The more people involved, the lighter the load. When you choose where to share your gifts, the office or a Consistory member can connect you with a mentor.

Volunteers for Ministry of Music & Fellowship Time Treats If you are interested in volunteering to do a Ministry of Music, or to provide treats for after church fellowship time, there are sign up sheets on the foyer table.

Cinderella's Closet update: One of our 'missions' is Cinderella's Closet, which provides FREE prom dresses to area high school girls that would like to attend prom, but have a difficult time affording prom dresses. We've been able to provide 12 girls with prom dresses this 2025 season. Julie Needham has been running the program since Deb Veldhuizen moved. Next Prom Season, spring of 2026, will be Julie's last year of doing Cinderella's Closet. **We will be looking for someone to possibly take over beginning with the 2027 spring prom season.** If you or anyone you know, would like to help with this, please let the church office know, and next spring 2026, you can help and work with Julie, and then be ready to take over for spring 2027. Please start passing the word to others, or pray about possibly helping with this yourself.

Local "Girls on the Run" volunteer opportunities available: If you or someone you know would like more information on being a local "Girls on the Run" Coach, check out the information by the church offices. This is a program aimed at girls in grades 3rd—5th, and meet twice a week at local elementary schools after school hours. As a coach, you will guide small groups of girls through curricula that helps girls develop essential skills to lead an emotionally and physically healthy life; participate in dynamic discussions, inclusive activities and fun games; learn the value of setting goals by preparing for a celebratory 5K; make a difference locally by planning and implementing a community impact project. This program runs for 10 weeks, and meets twice a week beginning late February thru May. You do not need to be a runner to be a GOTR coach. You do need to go thru Coach Training and a background check. Two sites in Yankton—Lincoln Elementary and Beadle Elementary are in need of coaching support.
