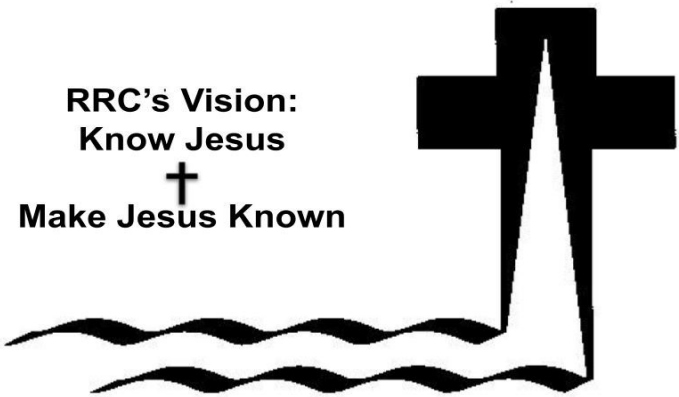

\*A while back we invited people to pray at 3:05 based on a passage from John 15:5. The Consistory has decided to update the time we are praying and the verse we are praying over. This comes from the work that Consistory has been doing, we invite you to pray at 1:08 every day based on Acts 1:7-8 NIV, which says, "He said to them: 'It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'"

**Community Fundraiser available:** Pathways Shelter for the Homeless provides compassionate care to individuals and families experiencing homelessness in our community. Last year, 90 children were sheltered with their families. Most of these families had a prior address in Yankton. In addition, Pathways assisted 45 individuals in avoiding homelessness.
